FaceTory's announces new Urban Calm range

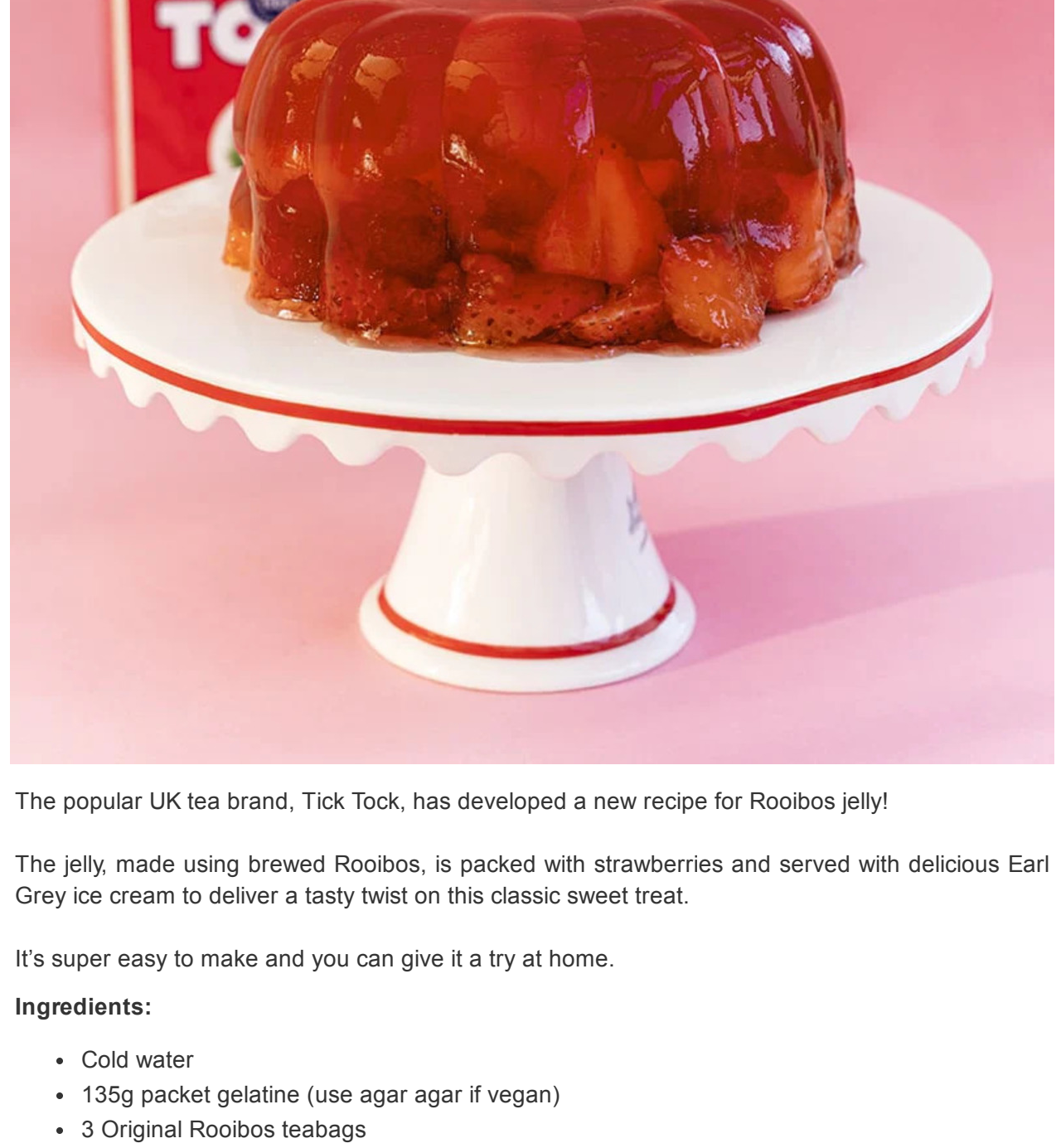

The jelly, made using brewed Rooibos, is packed with strawberries and served with delicious Earl Grey ice cream to deliver a tasty twist on this classic sweet treat.

It's super easy to make and you can give it a try at home.

Ingredients:

- Cold water
- 135g packet gelatine (use agar agar if vegan)
- 3 Original Rooibos teabags
- 330ml boiling water
- 75g raspberries
- 75g strawberries, halved
- Earl Grey Rooibos Ice Cream, to serve

Method:

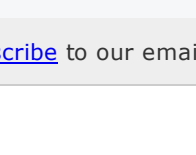
1. Half fill the bowl with cold water and lay the gelatine sheets in it to soften them.
2. Add the Rooibos teabags into a measuring jug with the boiling water. Leave to steep for 3 minutes, and then remove and discard the teabags.
3. Take the gelatine sheets out of the cold water and stir them into the tea. Leave the mixture to cool.
4. Once cool, add the raspberries and strawberries to the mixture. Pour into the jelly mould (we used a 1 000 ml mould) and place in the fridge to set for 5-6 hours.
5. Serve with a scoop of Earl Grey Rooibos Ice Cream and enjoy!
